PROJECT UPDATE

Construction work on the solar farm is expected to start in October.

TransGrid will be delivering the substation's two main transformers to site on the 23rd/24th and 26th/27th September. These deliveries will be undertaken by two over-dimensional vehicles up to 54m long and 5m wide. The truck will travel at a maximum speed of 50km/h and will have two front pilots and one rear pilot to provide warning.

Wollar Solar Farm has received approval for the modification to the development consent. This was reviewed by Council, Transport for NSW and the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). Full details on the modification can be found here:

Changes to the project include additional vehicle movements, amended access routes, more workers, and higher panels:

- 36 AV/B-double vehicles per day (up from 26)
- 72 truck movements per day (no change but a greater proportion will be AV/B-doubles)
- 2 oversized vehicles per day, with a maximum of 60 across the life of the project
- Revised access route for transformers to avoid a bridge with a lighter load limit
- Increase the maximum number of workers from 320 to 400
- Increase panel height from 4m to 5m

SUBSTATION PROGRESS

The substation will collect power generated from the solar panels and deliver it to the local electricity network via the existing overhead transmission line crossing the site.

Most of the foundations for the substation have been completed and Transgrid is now delivering the major electrical equipment and buildings for the substation. The major deliveries will occur during September and October.

Traffic control will be in place as required on Barigan Road to ensure safety for all road users. Some deliveries may require slowmoving vehicles and we appreciate your patience during these periods.
