In response to this complaint, the project team has conducted a series of pre-start talks with the contractor teams to highlight traffic and road safety when travelling to and from Wollar Solar Farm, including reiterating this to all individuals who drive the shuttle buses that transport workers to nearby towns, and also reminded contractors about the importance of driving to the conditions on local roads, and to ensure that suitable main thoroughfares are utilised to reduce the impact on residents in Wollar village. WSF also contacted local police to ask for their assistance in monitoring traffic in the local area.
